Rate CSP-D  
Commercial and Small Power – Demand

Availability:

Available to all consumers for three-phase service located on or near the Cooperative's lines for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements do not exceed 50 kW.

Applicability:

To all consumers served by the Cooperative.

Type of Service:

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at Cooperative's standard voltages.

Monthly Rate:

Grid Connectivity Charge:	\$ 52.50
Demand Charge: Maximum Demand, per kW	\$ 5.57
Energy Charge, per kWh:	\$ 0.10359

Determination of Maximum Demand:

The consumer's Maximum Demand shall be the maximum rate at which energy is used, measured in kilowatts (kW), for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during each month for which service is received and a bill is rendered, as determined by the Cooperative's metering equipment at the consumer's metering point.

Adjustments

The Energy Charge includes cost recovery for Energy Delivery and Power Supply. The portion of these charges attributable to Power Supply may be adjusted annually based upon projected wholesale power costs. These adjustments will be published at least 30 days prior to their effective dates.

In addition to the rates and charges described above, consumers will be billed a monthly Power Cost Adjustment for all kWh consumed.
