#### **LARGE TREES**

## Height/spread of more than 40 feet, such as:

- Maple
  Birch
- Oak
- Sweetaum
- Spruce Linden
- Pine

#### **MEDIUM TREES**

## Height/spread of 25 to 40 feet. such as:


- Washington hawthorn
- Goldenraintree
- Eastern redbud
- American arborvitae
- Dogwoods

### **SMALL TREES**

Avoid planting within 20 feet of power lines. When planting within 20 feet is unavoidable, use only shrubs and small trees.

# Height/spread of no more than 25 feet such as:

- Star magnolia
- Crabapple
- Lilac
